The 2026 State Range Judging Practice Site Location is east of Carrington along Highway 200. It is 14 miles east of the round-a-bout in Carrington (by Caseys). Practice site is directly on the north side of highway 200 and at the Grace City highway junction. The pasture contains a high hill with a cell tower at the top (can't miss).
