Practice Site Information:

The **RED** circled area marks the location of the practice site. The **GREEN** dot indicates the gate entrance to enter the practice site, off 30th Avenue West. Take I-94 Exit 59 onto 30th Avenue West to the practice sites. The Hawthorn Suites by Wyndham is located to the west of the **RED** circle. The **BLUE** dot is the flagpole with the box of practice site packets, located on the NDSU Dickinson Research Extension Center facility (contest headquarters).
