RE: Livestock Inspection at the State Fair

Veterinarians from the Animal Health Division will be available for inspections beginning at 3 pm on July 22nd. All cattle, sheep, swine, and goats must be inspected prior to unloading. Unloading must occur each day between 6 am and midnight, but if exhibitors are planning to arrive prior to 8 am or after 10 pm, they should call in advance to ensure that one of the state veterinarians is on the grounds when they arrive, except on Tuesday, when someone will already be on the grounds at 7 am. Contact numbers for each date are below. Animals may NOT be unloaded directly into the tie-out area before they are inspected by the state veterinarian on duty.
