



National FFA Week Implementation Guide – North Dakota

This guide is a resource for agriculture educators, advisors, chapter FFA officers, state FFA officers, state FFA staff, alumni and supporters to assist in planning and executing an engaging National FFA Week experience for the FFA chapter, school and community.

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- 2. Emoji Guessing Game:** A fun, low-prep activity that challenges students to identify FFA Career and Leadership Development Events and FFA events using emoji clues. This game works well as a bell ringer, small-group challenge, or meeting icebreaker during FFA Week.
- 3. FFA Week Statewide Bingo Challenge:** A week-long, statewide Bingo challenge designed to build excitement and connection during National FFA Week. Chapters play one official Bingo card throughout the week as numbers are announced daily by ND FFA State Officers, with opportunities to win multiple prizes.
- 4. ND FFA Trivia Challenge:** An interactive trivia activity that tests participants’ knowledge of ND FFA State Officers and State Staff. This challenge works well as a classroom activity, chapter meeting opener, or friendly competition during FFA Week.
- 5. FFA Week Family Feud – Ag Teacher Edition:** A daily email-based Family Feud game designed specifically for agriculture teachers. Participants submit their guesses to daily questions, earn points based on popular responses, and compete for daily prizes.
- 6. FFA Escape Room – The Case of the Missing ND FFA Charter:** A statewide, escape-room–style investigation where students work as teams to solve puzzles and recover the stolen ND FFA Charter before the end of FFA Week. This activity reinforces FFA knowledge, teamwork, and problem-solving through a fun, immersive storyline.

Tagged to Lead North Dakota Project

Description

The “Tagged to Lead North Dakota” project is an innovative initiative to identify and highlight exceptional FFA members who exhibit outstanding leadership potential and qualities necessary to serve as a future ND State FFA Officer. The project operates on the premise of recognizing and tagging exceptional FFA members within local chapters across North Dakota. FFA Advisors play a pivotal role in tagging those who exhibit remarkable dedication, leadership skills, passion for agriculture, and a commitment to serving their communities.

Each chapter packet includes three “Tagged to Lead North Dakota” postcards with three exclusive pins. Advisors should identify FFA members of any grade level and then “tag” them as potential future candidates. “Tagged to Lead North Dakota” is not only about identifying potential leaders but also about empowering and nurturing their skills to lead effectively. By recognizing and supporting these outstanding FFA members, this project aims to foster a strong pipeline of capable leaders dedicated to advancing agriculture and the FFA’s mission within the state of North Dakota. Senior FFA members who were tagged are encouraged to apply by May 5th.

Description

Guess the CDE and FFA Event – Emoji Edition is a fun, low-prep interactive activity that challenges students (or teachers) to identify Career and Leadership Development Events (CDEs/LDEs) and FFA Events using emoji clues. Each set of emojis represents a different CDE/LDE or FFA Event encouraging participants to think critically about the skills, content areas, and real-world applications associated with each event

This activity is designed to spark conversation, reinforce familiarity with FFA competitive events, and serve as a lighthearted engagement tool during National FFA Week, introductory ag classes, or advisory periods. It works well as a whole-class discussion, small-group challenge, bell ringer, or friendly competition. Answer keys are included in chapter packed mailed to each chapter, allowing for easy facilitation and quick review.

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FFA Week Statewide Bingo Challenge

Description

FFA Week Bingo is a statewide, week-long challenge designed to build excitement and engagement during National FFA Week. Each FFA chapter will receive one official Bingo card in their chapter packet and will use that same card throughout the entire week.

Each day from February 23–27, ND FFA State Officers will announce a new set of Bingo numbers via the Ag Ed Listserv. Chapters will mark their cards as numbers are announced. When a chapter achieves Bingo, they will email “BINGO!” along with the winning numbers to claim their win (a picture of the card).

How It Works

- Each chapter will play one Bingo card for the entire week.
- The Bingo card included in your chapter packet is the only card eligible to win.
- Each day during National FFA Week, ND FFA State Officers will announce a new set of Bingo numbers via the Ag Ed Listserv.
- Do not throw away your Bingo card! There will be multiple prizes awarded throughout the week, and your chapter's card will continue to be used for additional opportunities to win.

Bingo Number Schedule

- February 23–27
- New numbers will be announced daily through the Ag Ed Listserv.

How It Works

- Chapters should mark their card as numbers are announced.
- When your chapter achieves BINGO (any standard Bingo pattern), stop marking your card.
- Immediately email “BINGO!” along with the winning numbers to Nikki and Darin.
- When a chapter achieves Bingo, they will be contacted and given the opportunity to choose their prize from the available options at that time.
- Do not throw away your Bingo card! There will be multiple prizes awarded throughout the week, and your chapter's card will continue to be used for additional opportunities to win.

Bingo Patterns that will be accepted

- Horizontal – five consecutive squares in any row across the card.
- Vertical – five consecutive squares in any column down the card.
- Diagonal – five consecutive squares diagonally (top-left to bottom-right or top-right to bottom-left).

Important Notes

- Only one Bingo card per chapter may be played.
- Bingo cards may not be duplicated or replaced.
- Chapters must use the official card provided in their packet.

- Do not throw away your Bingo card! There will be multiple prizes awarded throughout the week, and your chapter's card will continue to be used for additional opportunities to win.

FFA Week Family Feud – Ag Teacher Edition

Description

Each day of FFA Week, a Family Feud question is distributed through the ag teacher listserv. Teachers participate individually by replying directly to the sender with what they believe is one of the Top 5 most common responses. Points are awarded based on response popularity, and the teacher with the highest total at the end of the day is declared the daily winner.

How to Play

1. Watch for the Question: A Family Feud question will be emailed to the ag teacher listserv.
2. Submit Your Answer
 - Hit Reply (not Reply All) to the email.
 - Send 5 answers, listed in the order you believe they appear in the Top 5 on the board (from most popular to least popular).
 - Responses must be submitted before 4:00PM Central Time each day.

Scoring

- Points are awarded for each correct answer that appears in the Top 5.
- Answers earn more points the higher they are ranked on the board.
- Only the Top 5 responses receive points.

Winning the Day

- At 4:00 PM Central Time, responses will be tallied.
- The teacher with the most points at the end of the day wins!

FFA Escape Room – The Case of the Missing ND FFA Charter

Description

To kick off National FFA Week, chapters will participate in a statewide escape-room–style investigation centered on a fictional mystery: the original North Dakota FFA Charter has been stolen. The charter, signed in 1929, represents the foundation of every FFA chapter in the state and its connection to the National FFA Organization.

Students are informed that the charter’s display case was found open, the alarm disabled, and a single clue left behind—a gold ear of corn sticker reading “Catch Me If You Can.” With FFA Week underway, chapters are challenged to work together as investigators, solving a series of clues and puzzles to track the thief, uncover their message, and recover the charter before the end of the week.

Each chapter will receive one complete set of escape room materials, designed for a group of 4–5 students. Directions and guidance will be provided for teachers who wish to create additional sets for larger classes or multiple groups. Answer keys, digital resources, and supplemental materials will be shared separately at a later time and will not be included in this implementation guide to ensure students do not have access to solutions.

This activity is designed to build excitement for FFA Week while reinforcing FFA knowledge, leadership, teamwork, and problem-solving skills. All materials are paper-based and mail-friendly, and chapter responses are submitted through an online Google Form.
