2023 State Range Judging Contest Practice Site Location



- Cross the Heart River bridge on Highway 6 and travel 1.2 miles south
- Turn right (west) on 44 Street (gravel road)
- Drive 0.7 miles west on gravel road to practice site. There will be 2 yellow gates with some pin flags sticking from the east side post
- A red tote contains ecological site cards, similar index sheets for MLRA 54, range judging manuals, and answer keys
