Purpose

The purpose of the Greenhand Quiz Leadership Development Event is to promote the development of foundational agricultural knowledge and FFA understanding among first-year members. By participating in this quiz-style event, students in grades 7–9 are encouraged to study the FFA Student Handbook and develop a deeper awareness of FFA history, structure, opportunities, and leadership principles. This event provides an engaging and competitive environment that supports students in building confidence and reinforcing their knowledge of the FFA organization early in their agricultural education experience.

Objectives

The Greenhand Quiz LDE is for participants to demonstrate their ability to:

- a. Recall key facts about the history, structure, and operations of the FFA organization.
- b. Apply knowledge from the FFA Student Handbook to answer multiple choice and true/false questions.
- c. Develop confidence and motivation for future involvement in FFA and agricultural education.

DISTRICT

The purpose of this activity is to allow for additional opportunities for Greenhand participation at the District Leadership meetings. Points count toward Chapter of the Day.

Chapters may enter individuals in the Greenhand Quiz event. There is no limit on number of entries. A team consists of the top three scores compiled for the team score. Individual participants taking the Greenhand Quiz must be in grades 7, 8, or 9.

A quiz of 50 multiple choice or true/false questions will be prepared with all questions coming from the current (16th edition) FFA Student Handbook. Pages 1–53 will be used. Answers will be recorded on Universal Form E, Form #705E-1.

STATE

The top two quiz teams from each district are eligible to compete in the state contest during Leadership Development Day.

The opening round of the State Quiz Contest will be the same as the format used at the District Leadership Conferences. The State FFA Association shall develop and provide a 50 point (50 question) written examination. This exam will be different than the exams used at the District Leadership Conferences.
