RE: Livestock Inspection at the State Fair

Veterinarians from the Animal Health Division will be available for inspections beginning at 3 pm on July 21st. All cattle, sheep, swine, and goats must be inspected prior to unloading. Unloading must occur each day between 6 am and midnight, but if exhibitors are planning to arrive prior to 8 am or after 10 pm, they need to make arrangements in advance to ensure that one of the veterinarians is on the grounds when they arrive, except on Tuesday, when someone will already be on the grounds at 7 am. Contact numbers for each date are below. Animals may NOT be unloaded directly into tie-out areas before being inspected by the veterinarian on duty.

From noon on Wednesday, July 27th through Saturday, July 30th, Nathan Boehm, Livestock Field Investigator (701-220-9352), will be on site to assist the Species Superintendents and the Fair Veterinarian with any animal health issues.

Rabbits and horses may be penned upon arrival. They will be viewed while penned and a more detailed inspection will be performed if deemed necessary. All out of state animals must have a CVI. As a reminder, due to concerns about avian influenza, there will be no poultry exhibited at the fair this year.
